


































































With an eye to the future

The important role of bees

Over the last few years, there has been more and more interest in the role of bees within our ecosystem. And rightly so! Bees take care of the pollination of more than three quarters of our food crops. Without bees, there would not be any cherries, apples, peppers or even coffee.





More colour and biodiversity in the living environment

In addition to supplying and planting flower bulbs, we want to broaden our horizon.
In collaboration with Griffioen Wassenaar, we offer colourful, low-weed perennials for public green spaces, but also for projects such as offices and parking areas. The great variation and the long flowering season mean that perennials make a major contribution to the biodiversity in the living environment. Perennials attract many different butterflies, bees and insects.



The perennials are sustainably grown in low-peat substrates, in an extra heavy pot size (P11) for a large root ball. The application of eight plants per square meter ensures rapid dense growth.

As a result, weed growth has less chance and maintenance is manageable.

Because the costs of management and maintenance are considered, we work with specifically selected strong types of perennials.

Before planting, the soil is improved with a special substrate that adds a good amount of long-acting organic fertiliser to the soil. This ensures a better structure of the soil.



Every year after the winter, at the right time according to the carefully composed care plan, the perennials are mowed, fertilised and mulched in one go with a mulching machine. This annual treatment ensures an environmentally friendly way of feeding and rejuvenates the crop, which also ensures a long lifetime.

If the buyer has reported a complaint to the seller in a timely manner and the seller has acknowledged this complaint, the seller shall only be obliged to deliver that which is missing, replace the delivered products or repay a proportional part of the purchase price, such at the seller's own discretion.

A complaint shall not suspend the buyer's payment obligation, unless the seller agrees expressly with such suspension.

The products can only be returned for the account and risk of the buyer and only after prior written permission has been obtained from the seller.

The seller will never be liable for the results regarding the flowering of the products supplied. It always remains buyer's responsibility to assess if the circumstances, among which the climatological, are fit for the products.

In case of a shortcoming attributable to seller, seller's liability is always limited to a maximum of the net invoice value of the products or to that part of the net invoice value to which a claim for compensation is directly or indirectly related.

Except in the case of legal liability pursuant to provisions of mandatory law and a deliberate act or omission, or gross negligence, any liability of seller for any further damage, among which any direct or indirect damage, consequential damages or lost profits, is excluded.

The buyer shall indemnify the seller against all claims for compensation brought by third parties in respect of which the seller is not liable under these terms and conditions

Cancellation

The seller will be entitled to cancel an order if the buyer has failed to comply with earlier payment obligations with respect to the seller or with respect to other creditors. This right may also be exercised if the seller considers the information concerning the buyer's credit rating to be insufficient. The buyer will never be able to derive any rights from such cancellations or hold the seller liable.

The seller will only be required to accept the buyer's complete or partial cancellation of the agreement, as a result of any cause whatsoever, if the goods have not yet been delivered to the transporter for despatch and on condition that the customer pays compensation equivalent to at least 25% of the invoice value of the cancelled goods. The seller shall in that case also be entitled to charge all costs incurred up to that time.

The buyer is obliged to accept the products at the time that they are made available to him. If the buyer refuses to accept the goods, the seller will be entitled to sell them elsewhere and the buyer will be liable for the difference in price as well as all the other costs incurred by the seller

Retention of title

in connection with this, among which costs of storage.

The ownership of the goods supplied by the seller does not pass to the buyer until the sums invoiced, plus any interest, penalty and costs, as well as all claims as a result of the buyer's failure to perform its obligations towards the seller under this agreement or any other, have been paid in full. The provision of a cheque or any other bill of exchange will not count as payment in this regard.

The seller will be entitled to immediately take back the goods supplied if the buyer remains in default in any way whatsoever with regard to the fulfilment of payment obligations. In that case, the buyer will be obliged to allow the seller access to the buyer's land and buildings for this purpose.

The buyer must store the goods subject to a retention of title separately from the other goods, in order to be able to continue distinguishing the goods of the seller.

As long as the delivered goods are subject to a retention of title, the buyer may not sell, encumber or pledge these goods, or otherwise place them under the control of third parties, other than as part of its normal business operations. The buyer shall, however, not be permitted to sell the goods within the context of its normal business operations if it has applied for a suspension of payments or if it has been declared bankrupt.

If the buyer fails to perform, fails to perform in a timely manner, or fails to perform to a sufficient degree any of the obligations arising for it from the concluded agreement, or if a well-founded fear exists of such failure occurring, as well as in the case of an application for a suspension of payments order, bankruptcy or the liquidation of any of the buyer's businesses, as well as in the event of the buyer's death, or dissolution if the buyer is a company, or if there is any change in the type of company or in its management or in the contribution made by the company's activities, the seller will be entitled, without notice of default or legal intervention being required, to suspend its own obligations for a reasonable period or to annul the agreement without being held liable for any compensation.

The claim of the seller with respect to the part of the agreement already performed, as well as damage arising from the suspension or termination, which damage includes lost profit, shall be immediately due and payable.

Intellectual property rights

 $The seller \ reserves \ all \ rights \ which \ it \ has \ in \ relation \ to \ intellectual \ property \ rights \ in \ respect \ of \ products \ it \ has \ supplied.$

With regard to cases in which it is apparent from the seller's catalogue or from the agreement entered into by the parties that a variety is protected by plant breeder's rights - which is indicated by a letter R or P after the name of the variety concerned - the buyer will be bound to fulfil all the obligations the said rights entail. Any failure to comply with this stipulation will result in the buyer being liable for the losses incurred by the seller or any third party.

13. Severance

Should any provision of these general terms and conditions of sale and delivery be non-applicable or in conflict with public order or the law, only the provision in question shall be deemed as not having been written and the rest of the conditions shall remain fully in force. The seller reserves the right to amend the inadmissible provision in order to make it legally valid.

Jurisdiction, forum

Any disputes, even if only considered as such by one of the parties, will be put before the competent court in the district in which the seller is registered, without affecting the right of the seller to have the dispute heard by another competent court.

All offers and agreements concluded between the buyer and the seller shall be exclusively governed by the laws of the Netherlands.
